Fionan Mackessy made history in the Cooley Mountains by becoming the first Kerry man to claim the M. Donnelly GAA All-Ireland Poc Fada senior title in August 2023.

The Kingdom hurler came good at his very first attempt and completed the challenging circuit in just 48 blows. Former winner Colin Ryan of Limerick (pictured on the front cover) also took 48 pucks but Mackessy beat him to top spot thanks to the 62 metres he added on, compared to Ryan's 16 metres.
